

Fundraising Policy

Purpose

To establish a policy for the Shasta Children and Families Commission (Commission), relating to the use of Commission funds to support fundraising activities.

Background

The Commission recognizes the potential benefit of supporting fundraising activities. However, after thorough consideration, it has been determined that requests for Commission funds that include fundraising activities will be denied.

Policy

Commission funds shall not be used for fundraising activities. Applicants pursuing any type of Commission funding may not include fundraising in the proposed activities.

Should an application for funding include fundraising activities, the application will not be eligible for review and will not be considered for potential award of funding.

Procedure

- A. First 5 Shasta Requests for Application now include the following clause:
First 5 Shasta funds may not be used for fundraising.
- B. Funding proposals submitted to First 5 Shasta that contain fundraising activities will not be considered for potential award of funding.
